Read through the following scenarios and discuss when the situation could be a tattling or reporting situation when told to a trusted adult.

- 1) You see a student throwing rocks at another but is not in your section of the schoolyard and you are with your friends**
- 2) You know that passing notes in class is against classroom rules, you see someone passing a note.**
- 3) You see one of the popular girls tease a boy. At first, you think it is a joke, but after a while you notice that others have joined in to tease him. The boy just laughs it off, but you notice he is getting upset.**



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
